I am a resident of Spital, currently residing at [REDACTED]. I do not believe that Spital should be split up in the recommendations you are proposing, and I think it should remain with Hady in the same ward. The two communities are closely linked in a number of ways, for example, both communities share the same bus route and local shop; younger children all attend the same school and share the same play facilities; there are numerous local paths between the two communities and they do not identify with Hasland. Both communities are close to the town centre and mostly use the shops in town, have doctors and dentists in town, use the facilities of the town as there is no direct bus service with Hasland and the walking route is along a busy and dangerous road. The two communities socialise together through their children, local groups like Spital Arts and the Friends of Spital Cemetery and the Riverside club - all of which link the two together. Both communities are in the Church of England Parish of St Mary's and All Saints and regard the Crooked Spire as their parish church. It does not appear to make any sense to divide them in this way.
