# **Boundary Commission Review of Telford & Wrekin ward boundaries. 2021/2022**

**Submission by Councillor David Hopkins, Dawley Hamlets Parish Council.  
Second update to original submission dated March 22<sup>nd</sup> 2022.**

## **Boundary Consultations by Telford & Wrekin Council.**

Telford & Wrekin Boundary Review Committee held public consultations on two areas in the Borough on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> April. These were publicised in the media and on the T&W website. I wrote to the Chair of the Committee (copied to all committee members) on 9<sup>th</sup> April to ask if there were any proposals to hold a consultation for the proposed Horsehay & Lightmoor and Dawley & Aqueduct Wards. This was the content of my email:

*I notice that consultation meetings took place today (9th April) concerning the boundary change proposals for Ketley Bank & Oakengates and Madeley & Sutton Hill.  
Are there any plans for consultation meetings concerning the boundary changes for Horsehay & Lightmoor and Dawley & Aqueduct?*

I had previously sent copies of my submissions to the Boundary Commission to the committee and I had received a response on 30<sup>th</sup> March saying:

*‘The Boundary Review Committee is examining the issues relating to Horsehay & Lightmoor, Lawley and Dawley & Aqueduct in some detail.  
The Committee has decided to take some further time to gather views on the boundaries in question..’*

As of today’s date (24<sup>th</sup> April 2022) I have not received any reply from the Committee in response to my email sent on 9<sup>th</sup> April. There has been no further consultation that I am aware of.

I do not understand why there has been no consultation or follow up of any sort from the Committee for the proposed Horsehay & Lightmoor and Dawley & Aqueduct Wards given the comments I received from them on 30<sup>th</sup> March.

I hope that the Boundary Commission, for their part, will look in some detail at the issues concerning the proposed boundaries for Horsehay & Lightmoor and Dawley & Aqueduct.
