**TELFORD AND WREKIN LOCAL GOVERNMENT BOUNDARY REVIEW  
CONSULTATION**

I would like to make a submission in relation to the Hadley and Leegomery area in your proposals.

I have lived in and represented the residents of Hadley and Leegomery for decades. The community is strong and vibrant. The parish footprint has long been focussed on Hadley and Leegomery and the community has grown and developed together over many years.

I am aware that you have received a number of submissions relating to the Apley area and there is strong feeling about its distinct identity. Apley is largely a later development and Leegomery was part of the initial New Town plan and has strong links to Hadley over generations.

I know that residents in Hadley and Leegomery are very much connected. I would urge you to look at this very closely in your proposals. Local people in Leegomery use Hadley centre which was remodelled and improved with supermarket provision a few short years ago. People across the area use local churches together and also significantly the local Gurdwara off Hadley Park Road. Local policing teams cover the area together. There is also a popular local footbridge that connects the community.

Children from Leegomery and Hadley go to the Hadley Learning Community and they network together, along with their parents. This is a fantastic school that was developed through the Building Schools for the Future programme and it serves Hadley and Leegomery children. This school was built following a long cross community campaign.

There really is a strong connection between the Hadley and Leegomery and I would urge you to reflect that.
