I would like to comment on your proposals for the Horsehay, Lightmoor and Lawley areas of Telford & Wrekin. I am one of the local borough councillors for the Horsehay and Lightmoor area. Your initial proposals for the Lawley, Horsehay and Lightmoor area don't reflect local community identity and I would urge you to look again at them. You have placed the area around Horsehay Pool and Horsehay Common into Dawley and Aqueduct. This completely fails to understand local community connections. The existing boundary with Dawley and Aqueduct should be retained. The area around Horsehay Pool and Horsehay Common needs to be in either a Lawley or Horsehay & Lightmoor ward. People in this area have a local community centre that they use together, a very popular local fish and chip shop, a brilliant local pool used for exercise and fishing and the new housing in the area has no connection or historical link to Dawley. Your proposals just split a community to achieve your electoral numbers – this isn't acceptable. You are pushing a community into a ward they no community connection with. Please look again.
