A public consultation is open until **I5 May 2023**

We are proposing:

- 76 councillors
- 35 wards
- Seven one-councillor wards,
 - 15 two-councillor wards and
 - 13 three-councillor wards



Our proposals mean that:

- One ward will be more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- Each councillor will represent an average of 4,283 electors

We aim to make sure West Northamptonshire councillors represent a similar number of
