Everton Together is a community group based in Everton West and over the last two years we have worked with the community /in bringing monthly litter picks in Everton Park and in the streets around West Everton. We have also run a fundraiser for Ukraine with members of the community in Everton West as well as working through the pandemic helping out at foodbanks, dropping essential items at venerable peoples homes.

We are shocked to find that Liverpool Labour are proposing to amalgamate the proposed Everton West with Scotland Road. It makes no sense to take away a ling standing communities identity by joining two wards that historically have nothing in common. It would make more sense to keep Everton West as a single councillor ward therefore giving Everton West something that has been missing for many years. A councillor who is going to be accountable. Everton West currently is part of the Everton Ward whilst Scotland Road is

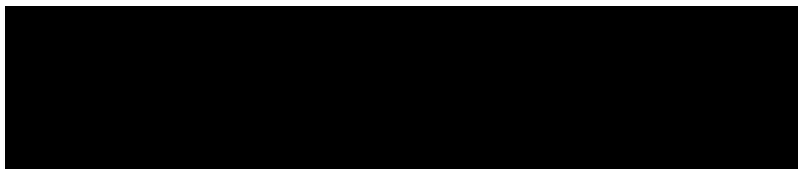
currently part of Kirkdale. It seems that amalgamating the new proposed Scotland Road ward with the proposed Vauxhall ward would keep both community identities intact.

We feel that taking away our heritage will have a detrimental impact on the community as having a single member ward would give us a representative who is more approachable, visible and accountable rather than two members who can simply hide behind each other as that's happening now with two Labour and one Independent councillors its is almost impossible to get hold of any of them. I would like you to consider our points please.
