Norris Green is a close knit community and has always worked well this way, despite some difficult times the working relationships of long serving community groups has enabled a more fluent problem solving group, due us being able to share ideas and knowledge. To dilute this by splitting the Ward up makes no sense, especially given that the community is very transient in people traveling across the Ward, accessing schools, community groups, shops etc - so any issues arising would be best placed in seeing this bigger picture. Also for groups such as ourselves who work across the Ward we would need to contact three different councillors depending on the boundaries that the particular issue arose, this would be too time consuming, as some of the issues are in all three wards, so we need to share this once. Also a shared skill set between three councillors would benefit the community, as they would have broader knowledge of the area just not their area. I feel that splitting the community would create barriers and an us and them arise rather than the close community spirit that we have fought so hard to achieve over the years.
