Comment text:

From London Road Area Local Action Team (LAT). This is an active group bringing together residents, traders, police, council officers, Ward Councillors, service providers etc. It has been running since 2008. Your proposal is to split the existing "St Peters North Laine" ward with a boundary running north/south along London Road. London Road is the key "high street" in this area of Brighton associated with a high incidence of anti-social behaviour, drug issues, street drinking, begging, homelessness, graffiti issues which seamlessly traverse the area north/south and east/west. In view of the prevalence of ongoing issues focused on this street the LAT is very concerned that the proposed ward boundary exactly bisects this single problematic area. We are extremely concerned that, under the new proposals, no particular Ward Councillor will be taking responsibility for issues that traverse the proposed Ward boundaries and that this will adversely affect an area which needs all the help it can get. Please can this proposed ward boundary be reconsidered, so as to recognise the coherence of this key area of Brighton. Philip Wells - London Road Area LAT Chair
