The Avenues Residents Association represent the residents of the unique conservation area of First, Second, Third, Fourth and Grand Avenues all part of the Knowles estate. Two roads in this conservation area are in the Brunswick and Adelaide ward in Hove which the boundary commission are proposing to amalgamate with Regency ward in Brighton. These roads have no relationship in terms of identify, community or architecture with Regency. Palmeira and Adelaide, Selbourne and Salisbury and Brunswick Town also currently in BA ward of Hove also are unique communities within in the Hove area. Brighton and Hove were separate local authorities until 1997 when B&H city council was formed. This proposal risks the losing the Hove identity. Brunswick Ward as it is, has: *a unique identity and history. *obvious boarders from Brunswick Square to Palmeira Square locations. *matches the constituency boarder at a General Election. *have residents who see themselves as 'Hove' not 'Brighton' and use Hove train station, Hove shops and Hove seafront. *is densely populated and needs councilors who can focus on the issues in this Hove area and not distracted by issues which drag them into Central Brighton.
