Comment text:

I am concerned that the streets in my local residents' association (St. Luke's Terrace , St. Luke's Road , Queen's Park Rise , Freshfield Street etc,) will be taken out of the Queen's Park Ward . Our local area colloquially known as ' St. Luke's ' looks downhill/ south to the Park and to Kemp Town and to the Sea for its community feel . The residents association has done lots of work building a sense of community and relationships with local councillors and other local community groups (like Friends of Queen's Park; Friends of the Pepperpot) and these would be severed. If you are physically there this becomes quite clear as you can see the Park and the Sea from many vantage points . The Park is essentially the extended playground of the local school which has no grassy areas for play . It has been like this for decades and i think this would disrupt the local community's sense of belonging . I cannot understand the logic of including the Phoenix site in Queen's Park ward - it feels very much like an ' add on ' for logistical convenience rather than being part of the Queen's Park community which it very much isn't (in a geographic sense).
