Dear Commissioners,

I am very dismayed at the suggestion that the parishes of Queenhill and Holdfast might be separated from Longdon Parish Council ward and instead become aligned with the parish of Ripple.

On the map, Ripple is quite close. **But separated by the River Severn.**
The nearest bridges are over 3 miles upstream and more than 4 miles downstream
So a round trip of at least 12 miles , compared with a quarter mile from Holdfast/ Longdon border to the Longdon Village.

Queenhill and Holdfast have worked together with Longdon council for about 50 years. It would be most unhelpful to stop now.

I had served on the Longdon Parish Council for over a decade a few years ago and sometimes now attend as a visitor.

My wife and I have lived in Queenhill since 1963 , our children all ended Longdon School (Now gone) and we both attend Queenhill and Longdon churches.
