Ripple Parish: The main settlement is the development in Ryall, which is certainly not rural, and is a couple of miles from Ripple's parish church and the "centre" of the village. This developmemt is only over the river bridge from Upton and is linked closely to it socially and economically. It would be very strange for it to be linked politically to the rural parishes downstream. Whilst it is historically true that Queenhill was once part of ecclesiastical parish of Ripple, with easy ferry access, to link it with Holdfast and Bushley to Ripple now and ignore Longdon would be very strange. No ferry now so a long drive round.....transport authorities are unlikely to put a new junction on the M50 for a District Councillor! Upton Parish: To slice off one of the wards (The Hook) ignores its strong links to Upton. It would also lead to complications at the Town/Parish Council level....District Councillors are welcome and very important at local council meetings, planning matters are submitted to local councils for comment....all difficult when the responsibilities for an area are shared out between overlapping authorities and councillors..
