The number of councillors should be as small as possible. I cannot fathom any private corporation having a board with more than 20 directors. This includes huge conglomerates, so why does a council need more? I suggest too many councillors allows for more too many cooks in the kitchen and, if I follow that analogy, a bad meal and poor recipes. The EY report was written years ago and is not based on the current council, but even that suggests 65 is enough. Personally I would go for less and if the original method was 3 per district then a more reasonable number would be 1 per existing district, so that's no more than 50. Ideally I would like to see less and have a full restructure so the councillors provide executive oversight and representation only.
