Comment text:

I have looked at the size and population of the other county councils. The average of county councils with a total population of about the same as Buckinghamshire (within 200,000) is 66 councillors. The average of county councils with a similar area size (to within 200km2) is 67 councillors. I am not really sure why the council is proposing 120 councillors. The only other council that has this number is Durham with 126. The next biggest is Wiltshire with 98. Both of these councils have a much bigger area to cover. 120 councillors would make Buckinghamshire the second biggest council when it is not that in either area covered or population. The average number of councillors of all the councils together is 72. The proposal by Buckinghamshire Business First of 65-80 seems to be the most sensible when the above factors are taken into account. I would suggest 75.
