### Comment text:

I strongly disagree with moving Upper Welland out of the Malvern Wells Parish and attaching it to Welland and Longdon. UW has strong links with the Wells and always has had. We are on the foothills of the Malvern Hills and within easy walking distance of the amenities in Malvern Wells. The AONB covers Malvern Wells and UW and that could alter the shape and size of future development. The school, Playing fields Nature Reserve and Village Green are all in the UW part of the Wells. We would lose our right to vote for MHT and, I believe, lose our levy Parking tickets for the Hills even though we will still have to pay it in our Council Tax.
