Comment text:

I live in the Altrincham ward and think the boundary looks right as it recognises natural boundaries, the old Altrincham market town boundary and also residents with similar concerns. Each Trafford ward is currently allocated 3 representatives. The population density in Altrincham ward is the third highest among the wards so should not be made any bigger. The neighbouring ward Broadheath is the second highest populated in the whole of Trafford . Each councillor in the Altrincham ward is projected to have approximately 3278 persons to represent while in a least populated ward he/she will only represent approximately 2526 persons. So more work and less relative representation within more populated wards. Also the retail, leisure, eatery establishments and schools in Altrincham attract more people from the neighbouring wards and far beyond greater Manchester so in fact the transient population of the ward is much higher affecting our needs and potential issues that require resolution. An increase in local government representation per head would be necessary.
