Comment text:

Wards should mirror what residents of a local area consider to be their neighbourhood. With the current Ward boundaries there are many anomalies. The Broadheath Ward includes an area to the east of the A56 and north of the Timperley Brook which local people consider is really Timperley. Part of Hale Central includes houses around Moss Lane. This is considered by local people to be Altrincham not Hale. It is strange that part of Sale East around Manor Avenue is included in Bucklow St Martins. There is a large countryside gap between the centre of population at Partington and the settlement along Manor Avenue to prevent the formation of a cohesive identity for this Ward. Is the name of this Ward justified as the vast majority of people living in Trafford would be unable to identify where it is. Given the growth of Partington, and the feeling of its residents that they are largely ignored, could this Ward not be renamed Partington. Given the close proximity of the Clifton Ward to central Manchester would that Ward not be better served by being part of the City of Manchester LA. Perhaps with the area of Northenden brought into Trafford as parts of Northenden identify more with Sale than with City of Manchester.
