I have lived here 42 years and seen many changes, believe not all good.

My part of Anfield known as the Rawdon residents. from Belmont road/Breck rd / Castlewood rd to Sedley street, known locally as deadly Sedley ,a street most will avoid.
We have gone from an area that was nice to live to an area that has seen many residents wanting to leave. House prices are one of the lowest in Liverpool.

These are our main concerns.

Drug dealing, Alcoholism, ASB, sex workers, curb crawling., Pop up brothels. (We have had 3) Shops mostly take aways or off licenses.

Dog fouling , fly tipping.

Abs landlords with no deposit, no references poor homes with poor letting agents, these tend to attract transient tenants with dysfunctional life styles , house clearance is to dump / fly tip in streets.

Too many HMOs , Airbnb, My house is between both and facing another. Supported living with very little support.

Serco housing, that caused so much stress to a neighbour with the dealing and asb he had major heart attack, sadly died. Because Serco are Government controlled you have to put up and shut up.

Anfield has 6 residents groups all formed to work together to make Anfield a better place. That's where I met Ros Groves and Billy Marrat plus other chairs of residents.

Rawdon had been so badly neglected by previous parties and councillors.

Ros Groves becomes our councillor , She was someone who knew us, listened to us , knew the despair and hurt in us.

She started making a huge difference fighting our issues not just putting sticking plaster over it, that wasn't happening any more!!!

Our next councillor is Billy Marrat. Two local councillor living amongst us, supporting us .Our voice was getting heard Third councillor is another local , Lena Simic. They all worked well together, for the good of communities and achieved lots.

Achievements

Street lighting , would you believe part of Anfield never had street or alleyway lights. Now we have. House burglaries are down .

Streets full of pot holes. They had them resurfaced. Our councillors came and seen what a dreadful job was done.. They went back and said it was unacceptable. Roads are to be redone. Alleyway roll out. WOW.

Our entries had collapsed drains , stagnant water, ripped bin bag. Dumping was dreadful. Then the rats, not only in the road but in most of our homes. It was horrendous . The rolls out and community bins has eliminated this. Our residents are so pleased with it and want to keep them clean they are now reporting any dumping .
