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### Comment text:

Parts of the existing Greenbank ward have a very distinct identity in the local area, going back centuries. For this reason, any redrawing of the boundaries should make provision for a Greenbank ward, even if it is smaller than the current ward. Greenbank: At present, the local area which is best known and understood as "Greenbank" is in the L18 postcode and comprises Greenbank Park, Greenbank Student Halls and Greenbank House (University of Liverpool), Greenbank Road, Greenbank Drive and Greenbank Lane. The streets known as "the Banks" off Greenbank Park and opposite Greenbank GP Surgery - Gorsebank Road, Hollybank Road, Elmbank Road, Oakbank Road and Beechbank Road are also in this area. Streets around and off Penny Lane are also very close to these Greenbank landmarks. Wavertree: Other parts of the current Greenbank ward, such as "the Dales" streets on the opposite side of Smithdown Road, and which have a different postcode (L15 as opposed to L18) are more commonly considered as part of Wavertree and could be incorporated into Wavertree ward. Toxteth: Parts of the L8 postcode, even further away from Greenbank Park, are thought of as Toxteth and could be incorporated into such a ward. Sefton Park: The "Avenues" streets near Sefton Park, with an L17 postcode, do not share the same distinctive "Greenbank" identity and have unique identities and histories of their own. They are much nearer to Sefton Park than Greenbank Park, and it would make sense for the area surrounding this large park to be in a "Sefton Park" ward - as the park is a focal point for the community.
