### Comment text:

Excellent idea to create fewer, one member wards. The current corrupted system has failed to uphold public engagement or accountability. Creating smaller wards with a single named councillor will help link areas more clearly with their representative. Lines of responsibility and reward will be much more obvious. Ideally members should live in the wards they represent -Liverpool's existing system has degenerated so much that some senior councillors do not even live in the same country. The new proposed boundaries as published in the local press this week make much sense, with Fairfield for example shown as a natural ward focused on the historic but long neglected Newsham Park, which will work far better as a discrete voting area than the two much larger three member wards (Tuebrook and Kensington/Fairfield) which currently divide it.
