I object to the proposal to change the current ward boundary for Parson Drove and Wisbech St Mary Ward. One of the new wards would be split by the A47, which is a significant barrier to community cohesion. Traffic on the A47 often comes to a standstill. The proposal to divide the village of Murrow into two new wards would not in any way benefit residents or community groups that are already established. Murrow is a deprived village and I would not like to see it separated from Parson Drove which has the amenities and community activities that I attend with other Murrow residents. The doctor's surgery and pharmacy as well as the post office and thriving shop that I use are all in Parson Drove. There are many family ties and friendships between the villagers that reside in both villages. The fortnightly coffee morning held in Parson Drove Village Hall is well attended by Murrow residents. The weekly Book Cafe that I attend in Murrow has friends from Parson Drove that meet up in there. I am not a member of Street Pride but because of the extensive advertising and information given on social media from both Murrow Street Pride and Parson Drove Street Pride I am aware that volunteers from both villages participate in not only litter picks but often work on environmental projects together in whichever village needs the help. As a resident of Murrow I appreciate the work the Street Pride community group does to keep our villages tidy and provide and maintain the planter displays throughout Murrow and Parson Drove which are a joy to see. Community spirit is a wonderful thing.
