Regarding the Istead rise, cobham and Luddesdown ward: For me, there is little logic to combining Istead rise with cobham & Luddesdown. Looking at the key points for a good ward pattern; Transport - not aware of any public transport links from Istead rise to cobham & Luddesdown, its not walkable for most, and can only be accessed by car through small country lanes. Community groups: Istead rise has its own established community centre, school, church, facebook group and website, not aware of any links to cobham & Luddesdown. Facilities: Istead rise has its own facilities, COOP, newsagents, dry cleaners, takeaways, hairdressers, dentist and doctors; it wouldn't be logical for the majority of residents of cobham & luddesdown to access these facilities due to the distance and poor transport links. Identifiable boundaries - Istead rise occupies a very self contained area of Gravesham, with Newbarn road on one side and the a227 on the other. If the number of councillors needs to be reduced it would be more logical to have one for Istead rise and one for cobham & Luddesdown
