

I feel most adamant that Woodingdean is the right size geographically for a ward of its own. It encapsulates one community of electors which broadly covers similar residential issues, social classes, and identities. Shunting any other area would be a negative addition. Ovingdean for instance is much more suited to being coupled with Rottingdean and I am sure the residents there would agree. The issues that face Ovingdean are much more akin to those of Rottingdean than Woodingdean. Should the arithmetic still demand that Woodingdean is too small for a two member seat, might it be a good idea to reduce it to a one member seat. In my previous Borough, there was several one member seats for wards on the outskirts of the town serving about the same number of electors as Woodingdean has now.
