



Kemptown is a defined and distinct area of Brighton with an architecture, community and character feel which is unique. At the present time the area is split down the middle between Queens Park and East Brighton, which leave the community without any distinct representation. Furthermore the way in which the existing wards move back inland means that the distinctive character of the old Brighton 'seaside' is lost. I would urge that the boundaries are redrawn so that the whole of the area from Upper Rock Gardens to Sussex Square south of the Eastern Road is enclosed in a new Kemptown ward. I disagree with multi member wards in general, unless we have proportional representation. I would favour a single member ward for each ward of the city council.
