I think that it's correct that no new wards are created in the City, however I think the number of councillors should be increased to reflect the projected increasing population. Its important for democracy and accountability that there should be a reasonable number of constituents per Councillor; in this case I feel the best solution is at provide that there is still less than 4000 constituents to a councillor. This is relatively easy to achieve, if you were to have a threshold for electorates in each word and councillors you could add a member where the ward is projected to increase to above 13,000 in a ward. In this case it would mean that Goldsmid, Hollingdean & Stanmer, Moulscombe & Bevendean, and St Peters and North Laine would add a councillor. The other way would be to reduce the councillors in other wards and add elsewhere however that would reduce the ratio.
