Comment text:

1. Electorate sizes need to consider population density. A sparsely populated ward can create more work compared to population size than a densely populated ward. 2. Multi-member wards should be replaced with single member wards. Multi-member wards are less representative of the diversity of opinion within it. 3. Wards should reflect the boundaries of distinct settlements where possible rather than dividing homogenous areas or grouping together settlements that have no meaningful association with each other. 4. Borough wards should be aligned to parish boundaries to reduce confusion for voters. 5. Consideration should be given to moving Shifnal and the part of Buildwas division covering the site of the former power station into Telford & Wrekin from Shropshire Council. 6. Lawley is under-represented. It should be split from Ketley & Overdale which is too large a ward with too many distinct settlements. 7. The number of borough councillors should not be increased from 54.
