Ketley Parish Council response to the draft recommendations for Telford and Wrekin Borough Council

The draft recommendations were discussed at the full meeting of Ketley Parish Council on 13th April 2022.

Councillors noted the proposal for Ketley and Oakengates. The new boundary would be called Ketley. This will include Ketley and Ketley Bank.

It was felt that the community interests and identity were historically stronger between residents of Ketley and Overdale. Oakengates has a stronger link with Ketley Bank.

The Millennium Village area is currently split between Oakengates and Ketley. Councillors noted that the whole development would be better aligned with Ketley as it has had a strong association throughout its planning and completion.

Councillors agreed there needed to be changes in boundaries, and there was a community benefit in creating new wards.

Councillors supported the creation of Lawley as a separate ward.

Councillors wished to comment that the Review Proposal would see significant growth in Ketley's boundary, and consideration must be made on the impacts on Parish boundaries.
