Re: Slough Wards Electoral Review

Britwell Parish Council considered the Review at its meeting held on 16th March.

Britwell is one of three Parish Councils in the Slough Borough. Britwell is a distinct area with its own shops, library, community centre and playing fields. It is a discrete area on the boundary of Slough Borough and historically Britwell was within neighbouring Burnham Parish before being transferred into Slough Borough as a new Parish Council in 1973. Britwell has a distinct and unique community character from its immediate neighbouring areas, as evident in basic aspects of the physical landscape such as house types and road layouts, right through to community character and cohesion. The Parish has clear definable boundaries that are well understood and established and focus on the core of the Britwell community.

Britwell Parish Council would wish to see its boundary replicated for the wider borough ward boundary (as one of the constituent polling districts for instance) and would strongly advise that the Parish Council area is not split across two different wards but should remain whole within a ward. The name "Britwell" should also continue to be incorporated in the name of the ward in which it is placed.
