Dear Sir I am writing on behalf of the Bullbrook branch of Bracknell Conservative Association to confirm that the branch fully supports the Boundary Commission proposal for Bullbrook revised boundaries and an increase to 3 councillors. The proposal is that the boundary is moved from the centre of Holly Spring Lane so that it runs from the roundabout at the bottom of Holly Spring Lane, behind the gardens of the houses in Spring Meadow, Holly Spring Lane, Flint Grove and Kenilworth Avenue and comes out onto the existing boundary line on the Warfield Road. This would mean that all the 190 + houses of the following roads would move into the proposed Warfield East ward, Holly Spring Lane, Spring Meadow, Flint Grove, Kenilworth Avenue, Goughs Lane, Lynwood Chase, Dene Close, Candleford Close, Avon Grove, Blloomfield Drive, Enborne Gardens, and Old Farm Drive.
