Moving the South side of Coalway Road out of the Penn Ward into the Graislely Ward removes a very clear boundary with a very fragmented one that is difficult to follow. The proposed change seems to use the South end of the residents gardens as the new boundary and there are significant differences in size of gardens. Also, it means that the side roads off the South side of Coalway Road will also be confusing as to which Ward they are in. It is very clear now - why cause confusion. The residential housing stock in Penn is mostly large properties whilst Graislely is mostly relatively smaller stock. The South side of Coalway Road is mainly large (some very large) properties that fit well with the character of Penn but not so well with Graislely. Penn is an aspirational destination for house ownership - the property owners (including myself) would like to see their current address remaining as Penn. Note has been made in the submission about the number of electorates per councillor. Whilst Penn is a little higher than Graislely, it does not seem excessive and I am given to understand by a local councillor that the numbers of electorates bear little link to the number of issues or concerns raised by residents so I cannot see why this would cause a boundary change. I am not sure what to add to this submission other than to say my family and I moved into Penn from Wales 7 years ago. We would not have considered moving into Graislely. I would like to object to the change of boundary on Coalway Road.
