Splitting the current Lenham and Harrietsham ward is a ridiculous idea and not practical. Lenham Heath, Sandway and Platts Heath have always been regarded as a part of Lenham. Harrietsham has been linked in the same ward and, because of this, all share the same facilities that are mainly based in Lenham village: the doctor's surgery (Len Valley Practice), the County Council Community Warden, the Secondary School, the post office. The Community Centre is regarded by all as the main centre for residents' enjoyment, learning and information, and many clubs and societies are linked and used by all three areas. These include football and cricket clubs, dance club and ballet school, the Scouting and Guiding movements, Young at Heart. Lenham, Lenham Heath and Harrietsham are all represented and well served by their two Maidstone Borough Councillors and their KCC councillor. Hollingbourne is too far away from the heart of Lenham to share any facilities and/or common interests. The same applies to Headcorn. Using the railway as a boundary may be convenient, but it splits established communities who have been working well together for many years.
