Comment text:

SunnyHill is a recognised community which is currently split between Blagreaves Ward and Normanton Ward. 3/5th is one and 2/5th in Normanton. Currently and in the City Council's submission Sunnyhill Community Centre is outside and separated. It would make sense to give Sunnyhill it's own identity by creating a distinct electoral area with 2 Councillor representatives. This would require NM5 polling station in Normanton Ward being joined with Sunnyhill community that currently is in Blagreaves Ward. Blagreaves as an area is not known to anyone apart from in Council Election times. Most of Blagreaves is seen as Littleover - with the exception of Sunnyhill which has it's own distinct identity, and so should be amalgamated into Littleover with Sunnyhill as a distinct community and electoral polling area. Heatherton Village continues to expand and needs to be separated from Littleover and given it's own identity and Governance with 2 Councillors. Normanton should be compensated for it's reduction in electors by repatriating Normanton so that the whole of Clarence Road and Porter Roads and streets off them into Normanton. In addition a smaller part of Arboretum Ward can join into Normanton Ward with a new boundary taking all of Peartree Road and Proncess Street coming into Normanton Ward. Most people do not see the Austin Estate and Caxton Road Estates as part of Normanton and associate them with Sunnyhill.
