Comment text:

Heatherton Village has a unique identity compared to the rest of what currently constitutes 'Littleover'. This can be seen in how people label themselves. For example people in Heatherton consider it to have developed enough of it's own identity to have created a Facebook group just for Heatherton: <https://www.facebook.com/groups/521179274905181/?ref=share> Community groups such as the Scouts also often organise themselves around the Heatherton boundaries: <http://www.heathertonscouts.com/> Separated from the rest of 'Littleover' by Mickleover golf course, Clemson's Park, King George V Park and Derby Moor means that this area is also relatively separated from other parts of 'Littleover'. In comparison many people who live in Blagreaves think they live in Littleover. This is because their nearest shops are in Littleover village and because there is no clear marking point showing where Littleover ends and where Blagreaves begins. As a result it would make much more sense to ensure Heatherton becomes its own ward and to potentially merge Littleover and Blagreaves together.
