**Re: Local Government Ward Boundary Review of Slough**

I am writing to give my views in your consultation on the new local wards planned for Slough Borough.

I support the proposals for the wards in 'West Slough' and the wards in 'West Central Slough' as are set out in the sections of your 'draft recommendations' document published in July. These are recognisable neighbourhood areas and the divisions between the wards generally run along clear and recognisable boundaries that are well understood locally. The parish area in Britwell is preserved within the wider ward in a sensible way in the proposals too.

I support the proposed ward names for all of the draft wards shown within the Borough – in many cases these are used locally to refer to parts of the town already, and where new, these do reflect identities/areas that will be understood by local people. I also support the recommendation/plan for 21, two-Councillor wards – as this means every area has equal representation on the Borough Council.
