Dear Lead Slough Reviewer,

In response to your current consultation on new wards for Slough local elections, I am in support of the changes to ward councilor representation, whereby each of the 21 wards is represented by 2 elected councilors – this is a logical pattern and makes sure everyone still has a choice of local Councillor to contact.

I support the LGBCE's proposal for the planned Herschel Park ward, which gives a distinct identity to the community around and south of the town centre (often referred to by residents as 'Herschel Village as it is a distinct community).

I think the proposal from Slough Borough Council (presented at its Council meeting of July 21<sup>st</sup> 2022) in relation to Upton Lea ward and Slough Central ward is a better proposal for these two Wards than the proposal in the LGBCE booklet – the Council's proposal from 21<sup>st</sup> July better identifies these two distinct communities and groups them and their amenities together better than the LGBCE proposal – I therefore write in support of the Borough Council's proposal from 21<sup>st</sup> July for these two wards.

Overall I support the ward names for all 21 proposed new wards – as these reflect well-understood communities/neighbourhoods of Slough.
