I can't see the benefit of including the abbey ward area in with the Greenlands and Lakeside area in the new boundary. The area of lakeside and greenlands is separated by the Coventry highway. Abbey ward and riverside has more in common within the new north boundary than lakeside/greenlands, where issues and access to the area are vastly differing and limited. Abbey ward has common ground within the north boundary and is very much affected by issues and services here but has no commonality with lakeside and greenlands. Effectively riverside and abbey ward would be swallowed up and forgotten within the new proposed boundary and have little to no impact in its own area. The boundaries are better marked out in a lot of cases along the lines of the dual carriageways which act as a distinct fence around certain districts. A lot of the proposed boundaries follow the lines of major roads in the new proposal but not Abbey Ward which has been drawn in within an area distinctly different in terms of housing type, demographics, services provided, crime, social and economic background and lack of commonality. We'll be last in line, lacking in priority with virtually no common grounds with the Lakeside and Greenland electorate.
