Comment text:

I have lived in Oakwood for over twenty years. I support the Boundary Commission Draft Proposals in full. I am very much against counter proposals which would split Oakwood between three separate Wards because this suggestion is unreasonable and illogical. A strong community is not built by the random allocation of houses into various Wards based on numerical data. The Oakwood estate is already a cohesive area and residents would consider themselves to be part of Oakwood, not part of eg. Breadsall Hilltop. The Green Wedge to the North of the Ward is of vital importance to Chaddesden Wood Local Nature Reserve. The LNR will be best protected from ecological damage by retaining the Green Wedge within the same Ward as the ancient oak woodland so that the important link between the two can be represented by the same Councillors. The Draft Proposals maintain this link and therefore have my support.
