I have lived in Tonbridge for nearly 3 years now. I used to live in Waterside Reach, now live in Blossom Bank. I've also lived on Medway Wharf Road before. All of these places are in the same council area which makes sense to me. The River Medway brings them all together and Townlock is a great place to sit and relax. Therefore using the River Medway as a boundary is not very appropriate. In fact, the High Street forms a natural boundary, with the big bridge going over the river, so it makes sense for the boundary to remain here rather than including areas on both sides of the High Street in the same proposed area. The networks of footpaths connect all of these areas to their local shops and also to other areas in the south east of town, which are much more accessible than areas in south west Tonbridge by both foot and car using the A26 mini bypass.
