Comment text:

I understand the decision to create a new 3-member district ward covering the parishes of Brewood and Coven, and Blymhill as it has the advantage of including all of the parish within the new district ward rather than splitting the parish between two district wards which is currently the case. However, I strongly object to the suggested name of the new ward as "Blymhill and Brewood". The name fails to include the name of the major village of Coven. This will be confusing to electors like myself who live in Coven who are used to the village being clearly identified on ballot papers. Coven has a similar electorate to Brewood, and the parish was renamed "Brewood and Coven" by resolution of the District Council in 1996. I would propose that the new 3-member ward should be called "Brewood, Coven and Blymhill" ward as this includes the names of both parishes in order of the size of their respective electorates.
