I have lived in Thornaby all my life, I am 56 years old. I enjoy walking in its beautiful countryside everyday, with my dog, near the river Tees which is a 2 minute walk away from my home.

I live close to the boundary with Ingleby Barwick. I feel the green belt separating the 2 towns has been done well and sensibly following the natural lay of the land following streams and rivers, and it is therefore, very clear where each Town begins and ends.

The proposal to change this boundary whereby Ingleby Barwick acquires land adjacent to Thornaby Road, opposite Teesside Industrial Estate, seems preposterous. It seems the building companies are going to attempt to fool new buyers that the land, and by default, their new home, is in Ingleby Barwick when in fact it is blindingly obvious it would be in Thornaby, just a 100 yards or so off Thornaby Road.

By changing the home address from Thornaby to Ingleby Barwick the builders will be able to charge tens of thousand pounds more for each house – that is their devious ploy.
