I wish to lodge a complaint against a proposed boundry change

I understand that the Boundry Commissioners are proposing  
to annex a large section of land currently part of Thornaby on Tees,  
adjacent to Thornaby Road and Low lane.

It is proposed that this annexation of land from Thornaby be newly  
named Ingleby Barwick South.

Clearly this is a case of removing a section of land belonging to an existing  
and legally recognised unitary authority to form a new area.

Bassleton Beck is the defined boundry between Thornaby on Tees  
and Ingleby Barwick.

Thornaby on Tees is to the East of the Beck boundry and the proposed  
land annexation ( Proposed new name of Ingleby South ) is also to  
the east of Bassleton Beck boundry lane.

Whereas Ingleby Barwick is to the West of the Bassleton Beck boundry line.

As you enter Thornaby Road at the junction with Low Lane you are  
welcomed by our Town Sign " Welcome to THORNABY-ON-TEES.

This is not Ingleby Barwick and it is not " no mans land "

I call on the Boundry Commissioners to respect the people of  
Thornaby on Tees and the land within its borders and cancel  
any proposal to change the existing boundry and territory.
