### Comment text:

I live in October Drive, Breckside park for over 15 years and am a trustee of a community charity. I would suggest that the Tuebrook/ Edinburgh Park ward would be better titled 'Tuebrook/ Breckside park' as breckside park is central to the proposed ward and an already established community. My main objection is the division of the three Tuebrook wards into Tuebrook Larkhill, Tuebrook Edinburgh park and Stoneycroft. All these three wards share a common shopping area, community facilities such as the Hope centre and the Marlborough Road community centre, Peter Lloyd Sports centre. All three wards share school catchment areas. I would strongly urge that the three wards be combined, representing an area of complex needs, economic deprivation and a shared identity, as you have done for the 2 Anfield wards and the 3 Kensington wards. A shared three wards would give a greater electoral equality.
