Dear Commissioners May I please request you re look at your decision to place Spital into Hasland Ward. Spital has been connected to Chesterfield and Spire Ward since Sunday 1st September 1895 when the St Leonard's Mission Church became a satellite of the Crooked Spire. Spital has always been divided from Hasland by Spital Brook, also by the railway line now the by pass and still Spital Brook which runs parallel with the by pass and joins the Rother and the river Hipper just before the Rother flows under the bridge on Hady hill. I see you are using the St St Leonards road as the connection and possibly the fact that Spital children go to Hasland school it is the only local secondary school. There is also Hady Primary school which children from the local area go to. There is another connection on Calow lane into Hasland. You have a comment from someone to put Spital Lane into Hasland. Personally I would prefer all Spital to stay connected to Spire ward. If things really need to change and this is not possible. Please May I make a suggestion that would keep most of Spital in Spire Ward keeping most of its historical connection to Chesterfield. Taking all Spital lane from the junction near the Co op Valley Road ,Valley Crescent Quarry Bank ,Stanley Street, Hartington Road ,Alexandra Road East and Cemetery Road not forgetting the St Leonards Mission and placing them into the new Spire Ward. You could put all Hady into Hasland Ward via the road link on Calow Lane. Hasland ward would then acquire another school as well. It would make the map of the new Wards look different, from as it is now proposed but I believe the numbers would be compatible . Fingers very crossed. Thank you for your time
