Dear Sirs

I am writing with regards to the proposal that Revere Way is moved to Court Ward. I strongly object to this proposal.

As a resident of Revere Way, my community ties lie with Ewell (both Ewell West and Ewell Village). If I am asked where I live, I always say Ewell, so to be allocated elsewhere is not acceptable in my view.

In relation to the wards, I understand that Court Ward is not currently represented by the Residents Association (which Ewell West and other areas are). I feel that the Residents Association is best placed to represent the needs of Revere Way and its residents and do not agree with the street being moved to a different Ward that has different representation.

From a geographical point of view, the road is the first you get to when leaving Ewell West Station and driving towards Ewell West, so for it to not be covered by West Ewell Ward is, quite frankly, ridiculous.

Finally, I think that moving Revere Way from West Ewell Ward to Court Ward could affect the value of my property detrimentally. Has this been considered? Understandably, I cannot support a proposal that could cause me to be worse off financially. Although the properties in Revere Way are unique to the area, being townhouses, they clearly are closer in nature to those on Station Avenue etc than those off Longmead. I also suggest that the inclusion of the properties on Revere Way, being quite minimal in number, would make little difference.

On the above basis, I object the proposal and suggest you look elsewhere to provide the desired electoral equality.

If you have the information on property prices and how this has been considered, please do provide the information.
