As the Chair of Stamford Ward Residents' Association, I am somewhat perplexed that Court Recreation Ground has been removed from the Ward. It seems a strange recommendation, as putting this into Epsom Town Ward will have no effect on the Councillor numbers or housing as only 1 property with 18 residents is involved.

Court Recreation Ground is fortunate to have the many Friends of Court Rec to look after the area, undertaking such necessary tasks as watering new trees and tending the flowers. These Friends all live within Stamford Ward and if "Court Rec." is removed from Stamford Ward, then there is a distinct danger that these volunteers who look after the area will no longer be so committed as a group to maintain this green area and that it will therefore start to deteriorate from the consequent lack of general maintenance.

Court Recreation Ground has been within Stamford Ward for the last 85 or more years and it would be a great loss to the Ward and to those many generations of families within the Ward. who have cared for it all these years.

I would therefore ask you not to remove "Court Rec." from Stamford Ward.
