### Comment text:

Electoral equality- It is important and fair that each Councillor for the different wards represent the same number of electors where possible. This gives Councillors an equal voice across Waverley - For the democratic process to work effectively this is important.. This will also give Councillors an opportunity to create stronger community links across their ward too. Community Identify - Having a larger ward, in Alfold for example will give the Councillor greater opportunities to build on transport links particular when Dunsfold Park gets off the ground. There is also the opportunity to work on larger improved community groups and facilities. Currently in Alfold the Councillor only has a rather small sport centre and Church to work with. It would be tremendous if our Councillor has a voice over Dunsfold and interplay the development of Dunsfold to the benefit of Alfold and Chiddingfold. Effective and Convenient local Government - Alfold Ward is too small to be represented effectively. With only several hundred homes there is little benefit of having it as a separate ward.
