Thank you for considering my comments submitted during the earlier consultation and taking on board some of my points and suggestions. I don't intend to challenge the main final draft recommendations and wish to confirm that I support Whatton in the Vale Parish remaining within the Cranmer Ward.

I will be grateful for further clarification of the boundary line separating Bingham North and South and the detail regarding the proposed four Ward boundaries for Bingham Town Council.

RBC Bingham - I understand the boundary line runs down the centre of Nottingham Road and turns south onto Tithby Road, then turns east onto The Banks. Does the boundary run down the centre of the road or behind the houses running east on the Toothill School site? I think the boundary turns north out of The Banks on to Grantham Road, towards the town centre, north along Cherry Street, west along Church St and perhaps north through the Robert Miles Primary School land to join the railway line eastwards. Am I correct in that interpretation of the maps you have shown?
