## **Review of Rushcliffe Borough Wards, [REDACTED] input**

This is a personal contribution to the review of Rushcliffe Wards. I am a Keyworth Parish Councillor and have been intermittently since January 2008. I am not attempting to provide a comprehensive input for the whole Borough but am focussing on Keyworth and surrounds while hopefully remaining aware of the broader context.

It is my view that:

- a) The existing polling districts are sound with appropriate boundaries and can, at least in the area of Keyworth, be used as building blocks for Rushcliffe Borough Wards.
- b) The ideal for effective representation would be all single member wards. I understand why this will not always be possible but hope that this review will at the very least reduce the number of 3 member wards in Rushcliffe.
- c) Every ward proposed should be within 10% of the target of 2,432 electors per councillor based on the 2027 electorate projections you have provided.

I therefore propose the following wards:

### **Keyworth East**

Polling District KWKS1, 2,277 electors so target -6%

### **Keyworth West**

Polling District KWKS2, 2,527 electors so target +4%

### **Keyworth North, Plumtree and Stanton** (might need a better name!)

Polling Districts: KWKN 2,077 electors.

TOPL 218 electors.

KWST 359 elector.

Total 2,654 electors so target +9%.

Part of Keyworth North is called Plumtree Park reflecting community identity and Stanton on the Wolds is, in part, contiguous with Keyworth. Also the only other option for Plumtree would be to add it to Tollerton which would then be an oversize ward.

### **Tollerton**

Polling District TOTO, 2,636 electors so target +8%.
