This response is on behalf of Fenny Compton Parish Council. Fenny Compton is currently part of the Napton & Fenny Compton ward.

Fenny Compton has close ties to the neighbouring parishes of Farnborough, Burton Dassett and Avon Dassett, driven by their close proximity and children attending the primary school in Fenny Compton. These parishes are currently part of two other wards and we believe it would make more sense if our parishes were in a common ward. We are affected by similar issues relating to flooding, the Dassett Hills, JLR and the M40 and as such this grouping would allow for more coordinated response through a common District Councillor.

We also have strong connections to Southam, driven by provision of local services such as the library, healthcare and policing. Several children from Fenny Compton attend Southam college. While recognising that the town of Southam has its own wards, it makes sense for Fenny Compton to be grouped with other communities that are also served by Southam in the same way. While we recognise that our current grouping with Napton achieves this aim, we have no other connection with Napton and as such the grouping makes little sense and creates a large geographic area for one councillor to cover.
