

LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN HEALTH ACT 2007

The Broadhembury (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2022

Made 2 November 2022

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

East Devon District Council (“the council”), in accordance with section 82 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 (“the 2007 Act”), has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations dated January 2022:

The council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient:

The council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section:

The council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 86 and 240(10) of the 2007 Act.

Citation and commencement

1.— (1) This Order may be cited as the Broadhembury (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2022.

(2) It shall come into force on the 1st April 2023.

(3) For the purposes of proceedings preliminary or relating to the election of parish councillors for the parish of Broadhembury to be held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2023 this Order shall come into force on the day after that on which it is made.

(4) Article 4 shall come into force on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2023.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“ordinary day of election of councillors” has the meaning given by section 37 of the Representation of the People Act 1983; and

Effect of Order

3. This Order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to any provision of this Order.

Number of parish councillors for the parish of Broadhembury

4. The number of councillors to be elected for the parish of Broadhembury shall be 12.

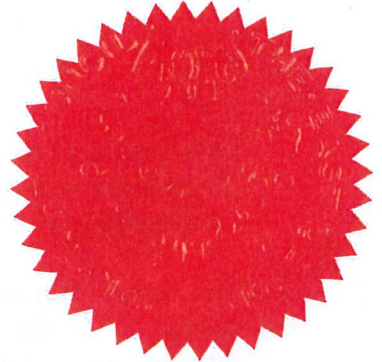
Order date
